Developing a care committee for Dementia patients in a rehabilitation setting

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Introduction: e traditional patient pro le in Clontarf Hospital is changing. ere is an increase in geriatric rehabilitation patients and therefore an increase in co morbidities associated with older age, cognitive impairment. ese patients have speci c needs and it is imperative that these needs are addressed from a hospital wide perspective.

Methodology: A Dementia Care Committee has been established in order to improve the care of patients with cognitive impairment through; sta education, development of care pathways and service improvement. An invite to attend the group was extended to all sta and disciplines. e committee has monthly meetings to provide guidance on the care of the patient with cognitive impairment and to increase awareness at an organisational level of cognitive impairment and its' impact on function.

Results: Areas of intervention/improvement have been identied and sub groups have been formed in order to address same.
