Background: Laparoscopic sleeve gastrectomy (LSG) is a common bariatric procedure. The staple line reinforcement (SLR) is a technique used to reduce the risk of staple line leakage. The sliding self-locking first stitch and Aberdeen knots are two techniques used for SLR. The aim of this video presentation is to demonstrate the technique of SLR using the sliding self-locking first stitch and Aberdeen knots in LSG.
