Vodouhe et al. explained determinants of adherence to intermittent preventive treatment for malaria with sulfadoxine pyrimethamine (IPTp-SP) in pregnant women in Parakou (Benin) [8].

Pinton et al. described on risk factors and clinical presentation of uterine rupture in the unscarred uterus: A case control study [10]. Goyal noticed on successful outcome in a rare case of large adrenal myelolipoma during Pregnancy Complicated by Uterine Inversion [19]. Nilanchali reported on carcinoma cervix in pregnancy—a challenge for all [20].
