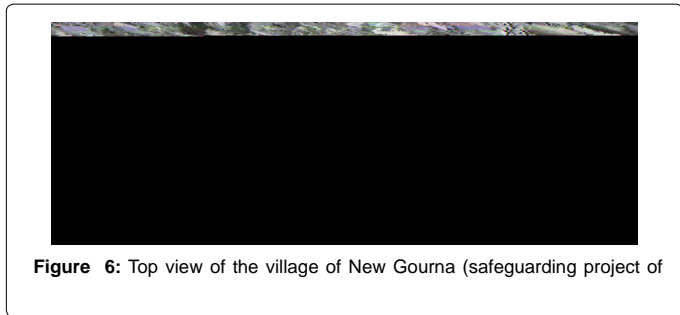


Figure 6: Top view of the village of New Gourna (safeguarding project of Hassan Fathy)
