

Isolated Ischial Lesions

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About the Study

The pelvis is a common site of origin of several primary and secondary musculoskeletal tumours, and other various pathologies. The ischium is one of the complex bones that make up the pelvis. The exact incidence of lesions affecting the ischium is unknown and considered rare.

In this study, we describe a plethora of ischial pathologies and describe their demographics and imaging features. A retrospective search of our tertiary orthopaedic oncology and radiology databases was performed to identify isolated lesions of the ischium over the last 30 years (1989-2018). Lesions with epicentre on the ischium were included in the study. We reviewed the databases for demographics,
