The cases of conjunctivitis further categorised based on etiology prevalence of allergy conjunctivitis was 62.66% and bacterial conjunctivitis was 24%. Prevalence of viral conjunctivitis was 13.33%. People with symptoms of conjunctivitis for the first time was 55.33%. Percentage of males affected by conjunctivitis was 54.66%. Percentage of females affected by conjunctivitis was 45.33%. Dust (35%) was the most common precipitating factor. The
